The following is a summary of a proposed Ordinance intended to be considered for passage by the Board of Commissioners of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania at the Board's regular meeting on July 1, 2003 at 10:30 a.m. at the Office of the County Commissioners, Courthouse Annex, 230 Market Street, Suite 101, Clearfield, PA, 16830.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF CLEARFIELD ("County") IMPOSING A HOTEL ROOM RENTAL TAX BY AUTHORITY OF SECTION 1770.6 OF THE COUNTY CODE FOR THE PURPOSES OF TOURISM AND TOURISM DEVELOPMENT; ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR THE COLLECTION OF THE TAX AND IMPOSING PENALTIES.

The proposed Ordinance would levy a three (3%) percent tax on the consideration received by each operator from all rentals of hotel rooms. The tax would be collected by the operator from the patron and paid to the County Treasurer. The County Treasurer will make distributions to the recognized tourist promotion agency designated by the County Commissioners. The purpose of the tax is to fund tourism, tourism promotion and tourism development within Clearfield County.
